The knowledge of the Italian language is not a strict requisite in our case, but it is

important a reasonable knowledge of English language.

The **PhD project** I am proposing is the field of **Organic Chemistry** and in particular on

the asymmetric catalysis and in the enantioselective total synthesis of chiral

biologically active compounds. The project is based on the development of new

cascade reactions and of new organocatalytic systems. I have also nice

collaborations in this field with Pharma companies, which widen the horizons of the

project.
