Prevention measures regarding the limitation of spread of the virus SARS-CoV-2

In line with the Rector's instructions from March 8, 2020, about the prevention measures regarding the COVID-19 virus, the Faculty of Chemistry and Chemical technology has adopted following measures:

- 1. Cancelled lectures at the following courses:
- Mathematics (doc. dr. Gregor Cigler), Lecture room B, Wednesday 10:00 13:00
- Inorganic Chemistry (prof. dr. Anton Meden), Lecture room B, Wednesday 8:00 10:00
- Inorganic Chemistry (prof. dr. Anton Meden), Lecture room B, Thursday 8:00 11:00
- Physics (prof. dr. Igor Muševič), FMF-Big Lecture room, Tuesday 8:00 11:00. The teachers from the mentioned courses are advised to use other forms of pedagogical work.
- 2. The course Physical Education has been cancelled.
- 3. It is advised not to visit the countries where the coronavirus epidemic had been confirmed.
- 4. It is advised not to receive visitors from the countries where the coronavirus epidemic had been confirmed.
- 5. All the non-urgent meetings, not necessary for the undisturbed activity of the faculty, have been cancelled.
- 6. The number of seats at the cafeteria has been limited.

The rest of the pedagogical activities proceed according to schedule.

Further, common measures for limitation of spread of the virus SARS-CoV-2 have to be followed. The everyday prevention measures have been published by the National institute for public health:

- Avoid close contacts with individuals that show signs of infection; the distance should be at least 1.5 meter;
- Don't touch the eyes, the nose and the mouth;
- Stay at home in case you get sick;
- Follow the rules of hygiene of cough;
- Wash the hands regularly

- Use disinfection liquid for hands in case where there's no water and soap. The Ethanol content in the disinfection liquid for hands should be at least 60%. The disinfection liquid for hands is strictly meant for external use. The cleaning and disinfection agents are not meant for cleaning or disinfection of the skin!
- The use of face masks is not needed at this stage.
- Avoid indoor places with a lot of people during the time of more often appearance of viruses.

The epidemiological situation in Slovenia and all the neighbour and other countries is followed all the time by the National Institute for Public Health, and we are following their instructions as well. If the circumstances change, we'll react accordingly and all the participants will be informed regularly, by emails, web sites and student information system STUDIS.

This is regulation is valid from 10th March, 2020 till including 23rd March, 2020.
